



Clatterbridge Hospital Mammography Unit



The project comprised of alterations & remodelling within the existing hospital to facilitate the installation of two new mammography scanners.

To accommodate the mammography department, various rooms within the X-ray department were stripped out, reconfigured and re-decorated.

New mechanical & electrical services were integrated along with necessary provisions for the power supply for the specialist equipment.

All the work was carried out within close proximity to the main hospital circulation areas
