



Runcorn Hill Park

New Visitor Centre, and Refurbished Lakeside and Garden Pavilions

Whitfield & Brown has recently completed the construction of new Visitor Centre along with Improvement works & reconfiguration of existing Garden Pavilion and Lakeside Buildings.

Heritage lottery & match funding has enabled improvements to commence to one of Halton's most visited green spaces. The recreational and educational space at Runcorn Hill Park has been enhanced by the new visitor centre and café, comprising of flexible community space, WC facilities and sufficient parking for 34 vehicles.

The new visitors centre serves as a central arrival point to the park and sits facing the woodlands, sports field, boating lake and children's play area.

Running parallel with the construction of the new visitor centre was the improvement works to the Garden Pavilion and Lakeside buildings. These modifications comprised the construction of a hipped roof; which creates a porch area providing rain shelter for the bowling club members; internal partitions and redecoration throughout.
