



Southport & Formby District General Hospital Alterations to A&E Department, Phase 6

Whitfield & Brown were appointed by Southport & Ormskirk Hospital NHS Trust to undertake the alterations to selected areas of the A&E department.

The works involved the stripping out of existing partitions, flooring and finishes, the installation of new windows in new openings, new partition walls, new doorsets, new finishes, new fittings and fixtures and new sanitary fittings with IPS Panels, and new flooring throughout. Alterations to internal below ground drainage, new external drain runs. A large amount of mechanical and electrical engineering was also undertaken by way of the installation of new light and power, nurse call, data containment, heated ceilings, medical gasses, ventilation, low temperature hot water (LTHW) and hot and cold water supply (H&CWS), insulation and soil and waste pipework.

The site is located within the existing A&E department and adjoins the X-ray department with occupied wards above. The refurbishment has created:

- Essential office space
- Female and male change/shower locker
- Staff room
- Four examination rooms
- Stores facilities
