



Sports Changing Pavilion, Widnes

New Sports Pavilion, Floodlit Multi Use Games Area Hard & Soft Landscaping

Working with Halton MBC, Whitfield & Brown have constructed a modern community sports facility on Liverpool Road, Widnes.

The site now boasts a new 1060m² fully DDA Compliant Sports Pavilion; Floodlit 685m² MUGA; hard and soft landscaping improvements and new vehicle access and car parking.

The single storey steel framed structure has a mixed palette façade including metal cladding, structural glazed cladding, aluminium casement windows and masonry brick/block walls. Internally 11 Changing rooms have been formed, including shower and toilet facilities, new plant room, store, social rooms, meeting rooms, staff room and kitchen. A new foyer and reception area have also been created.

The building services include mixed ventilation, underfloor heating, electrical installations and a sprinkler system.

External hard and soft landscaping offer a more appealing area overall and comprised the realignment of existing car park, the creation of disabled access spaces with the installation of security lighting, and a floodlit MUGA pitch. New paths connect the car park to the pavilion with additional security lighting, and the planting of new trees around the site. A rainwater attenuation tank was also constructed.
