Hope Chapel, also known as the “Oasis of Peace” has been renovated following a fire that devastated its copper pyramid shaped roof.

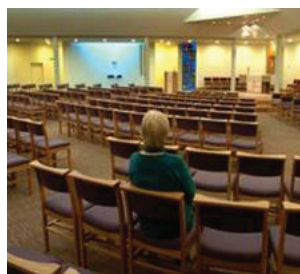
The chapel dating back to 1965 is positioned in the heart of the Hope Park campus and is used by the University and local residents.
