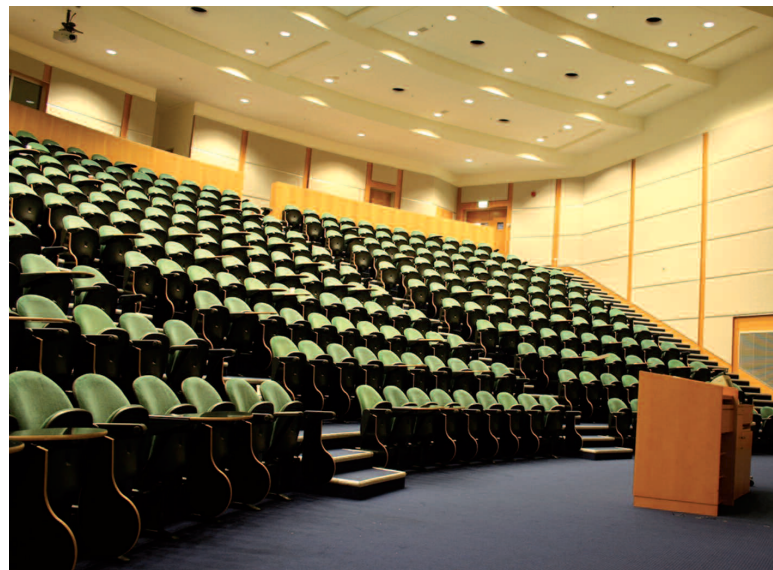
This project comprises the refurbishment of teaching rooms and lecture theatres with auditorium seating to 3 buildings at the University of Salford Campus.

The contract includes the refurbishment of 6 rooms in total with audio visual fit out to 3 rooms and high specification finishes with floating ceilings, feature walls, new lighting, heating and ventilation and new seating to the lecture theatres.

All works took place in occupied buildings in three separate locations on the campus.
