



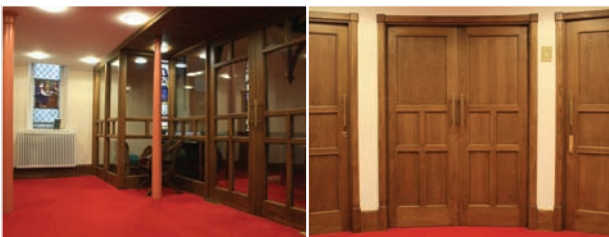
St. Nicholas Parish Church, Halewood

Refurbishment of St. Nicholas Parish Church

This project involved the internal refurbishment and alterations to the church, together with associated electrical and mechanical works.

Included in the works were the installation of new hardwood oak doors and screens to the front and side of the church. New mosaic floor tiles were put down in the entrance area to the church to replace the original tiles. The tiles were made and produced using the original mould from the tile museum, near Ironbridge.

Internally, a new disabled toilet facility was constructed and a small catering area added. Some of the existing pews were removed and new partitions with glazed oak screens erected to form a reception area to enable meetings, coffee mornings to take place.
