University of Liverpool Wood Park Farm Visitors Centre



This scheme involves the replacement of the existing roof, internal refurbishment of the Old Dairy Building and construction of a lean to extension to form new teaching rooms, washing and parking facilities. The project brief also included improvements to the thermal, structural and aesthetic characteristics along with modifications for disabled access.

Due to restricted ceiling heights at the first floor, the existing roof had to be removed, the walls lifted and a new roof installed. These works were postponed for four weeks during the programme whilst swallows hatched and left their nests.
